

For the sake of simplicity and continuity with our motto, I define the key actions of our mission like this:

The Bible Recap on the Bible app. is a great resource that will help motivate you in reading the Bible, and I encourage you to utilize it, or something like it this year! If you are not a "words on page reader," you can easily listen to the day's passages via the app.

In addition to Bible reading, prayer is a discipline we also encourage, but rarely give any instruction on. The Bible app has a "Daily Refresh" on its home page that leads you to pray in your own words using Scripture. If you struggle to "format" your prayer time. A similar, but even more structured resource that includes prayers for morning, midday, and night, is Lectio 365.
